Shirakaba 2 in 1

A perfect place to start your 8 Peaks stay. With plenty of short runs, it's ideal for easy lap-by-lap progression. The Pleasure Course suits first timers and beginners, with a friendly pitch and length, plus wide groomers for stress-free practice. Top it off with unreal summit views, popular ramen and crepes, and the 8 Peaks Snow Sports office on-site.

Pilatus Tatেশina

One of Japan's highest ski resorts (top elevation 2,237m), Pilatus is made for big-mountain cruising. From the summit, enjoy a 4km long run that's best suited to intermediate riders, with just two short advanced sections along the way. On the right day you may even spot frost-covered trees, and when the skies are clear the views stretch across distant peaks as you glide through the forest from top to base.



Lifts 2 Ropeway 1



Shirakaba Kogen Kokusai

With a gondola for warm, easy laps on cold days, Kokusai is all about smooth, comfortable skiing. Its long, wide groomed runs are perfect for letting your carving turns run free. For a slower pace, there's also a quiet forest cruise—an easy 5km-style long route where you can glide through the trees and enjoy the scenery at your own rhythm.



Lifts 2 Gondola 1



Royal Hill

Cruise down with beautiful views over Lake Shirakaba, making every run feel a little more scenic. Royal Hill is also great for progression, with a fun mix of kickers, boxes and rails that let you step up at your own pace. The upper section is wide and open, while the lower runs are longer and compact but surprisingly varied—perfect for keeping the day interesting whether you're carving, cruising, or sampling the park features. Night skiing is also available.

Snow Park

Right next to Ikenotaira Hotel, Snow Park is a small, beginner-friendly ski area that's perfect for a first day on snow. Most runs are beginner-focused, making it ideal for learning the basics in a relaxed setting. Along the way, you'll find fun features like gentle banks and small obstacles designed to keep kids smiling while they naturally build balance, control, and confidence—whether they're on skis or a snowboard.

Blanche Takayama

On clear days, you can even spot Mt Fuji from the summit—plus the famous Ski Jizo makes it a fun photo stop. A family favourite is the 3.7km long beginner run from top to base, giving first timers a real "I made it!" feeling and a big confidence boost. For more of a challenge, there are also natural mogul lines and steeper pitches that locals love. Most runs are around 1km long, so you get plenty of satisfying time on each lap.

Easy Access by Round Bus



These three ski areas are reached via our Round Bus, which loops through the 8 Peaks area throughout the day. Round Bus rides are included with your All Mountain Pass.



Dedicated Shuttle Service Reservation Required



These three ski areas are accessed by a dedicated shuttle vehicle, and the service is included with your All Mountain Pass. The shuttle departs your accommodation at 9:00am and leaves the ski area at 3:00pm to return to your accommodation. Reservation required. During peak periods, requests may be subject to availability.
